Recognizing the need to channel the energy and enthusiasm of the youth, the government declared Swami Vivekananda's date of birth as National Youth Day in 1984. The aim was not only to pay homage to this visionary monk but also to instill his teachings into the fabric of the nation's consciousness, especially among the		

younger generation.

The highlight of the celebration was the presence of Mr. Abhay Chaturvedi, a distinguished guest speaker and a certified Life Coach & Emotional Intelligence Coach practitioner. His expertise in coaching and mentoring individuals, both in the professional and personal realms, added a unique and insightful dimension to the event.

Mr. Chaturvedi's address began with a thought-provoking question about the significance of 9/11. Surprisingly, he redirected our focus to 1893, a pivotal year that witnessed Swami Vivekananda's historic appearance at the Parliament of the World's Religions in Chicago. Mr. Chaturvedi eloquently highlighted the importance of this moment, describing it as a landmark event in the history of interfaith dialogue that introduced Swami Vivekananda to the global stage.

As the audience tuned in, Mr. Chaturvedi recounted Swami Vivekananda's impactful speech on September 11, 1893, starting with the iconic words, "Sisters and brothers of America!" He emphasized how this speech advocated religious tolerance, the universality of all religions, and the imperative for harmony among different faiths. The speech not only captivated the audience but also garnered international respect, establishing Swami Vivekananda as a prominent and influential figure in the global spiritual and philosophical community.

Beyond the historical narrative, Mr. Chaturvedi's address delved into the contemporary relevance of Swami Vivekananda's teachings. He challenged the conventional notion of heroism, asserting that true heroes are those who practice tolerance and moderation rather than those idealized with vices in movies. The session concluded on a meditative note, underscoring the healing power of silence and peace on our minds.
