

Brief Description (4-5 Lines Max)	<p>A one day workshop on” Research Output Optimization” was organized at New Horizon College in association with Department of Research and Development, New Horizon College of Engineering and IIC. The Resource person for the session was Dr. Vinoth Kumar, Professor, Associate Head Innovation Ambassador, Department of R &amp; D New Horizon College of Engineering. The workshop was structured to provide a comprehensive experience. The first half of the session focused on introducing research, emphasizing its importance in today’s academic environment, understanding its necessity, and discussing the requisites for publication among faculty members. The second half featured hands-on training led by the resource person, who guided faculty members on research paper writing, identifying quality Q-rated journals, and facilitating publication through IEEE conferences. Dr. Vinoth Kumar guided the faculty members on common errors made when submitting papers for journal publication, shared tips for increasing the chances of paper acceptance, and addressed plagiarism during the hands-on training session. He also identified and addressed several common issues faced by writers, such as a fixed mindset about writing, lack of creativity, limited vocabulary, difficulty in conveying thoughts through sentences, and uncertainty about where to start the writing process.</p> <p>The faculty members appreciated Dr. Vinoth for the insightful session. Overall, the workshop was fruitful and beneficial for the attendees. The faculty members expressed their gratitude to the Management, Principal, and Dr. Vinoth for the opportunity to attend such a valuable FDP program, as well as to the R&amp;D Department of NHCE for their commendable support.
