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Description:

The workshop session commenced with the formal introduction of Dr. Vinoth Kumar K Professor and Associate Head, Department of Research & Development, New Horizon College of Engineering, Bengaluru, followed by his presentation on the importance of research and development in higher education. He emphasized that research is not merely a requirement but a meaningful pursuit of knowledge and innovation. He explained what constitutes a research paper and introduced the participants to the broader idea of "research culture," which includes discipline, originality, critical thinking, and ethical responsibility. He then elaborated on the different types of research publications, such as original research articles, review papers, short communications, case studies, and conceptual papers.

Dr. Vinoth guided the audience through the step-by-step procedure for submitting a research article, highlighting key elements editors look for—namely, the scope, quality, novelty, and significance of the paper. He introduced the standard IMRDC structure of a research paper: Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, and Conclusion. He explained how to effectively write each of these sections and stressed the importance of maintaining clarity, coherence, and evidence-based reporting throughout the manuscript. He then moved on to the topic of journal selection, advising scholars to evaluate journals based on criteria such as subject relevance, impact factor, indexing (e.g., SCI, Scopus, UGC CARE), review process, and publisher reputation, IPR. He classified journals into reputable and predatory

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categories and cautioned against the latter. The session also addressed the pre-review process, where internal or peer feedback before formal submission helps improve the paper's quality. An essential segment of the workshop focused on avoiding plagiarism, where Dr. Vinoth explained best practices such as proper citation, paraphrasing, and the use of plagiarism-checking tools to ensure academic honesty.

The session concluded with valuable tips for good scholarly practice, including consistent reading, maintaining a research journal, collaborating ethically, and focusing on impactful contributions rather than mere publication counts. Dr. Vinoth also suggested reputable journals for different fields and encouraged participants to aim for quality over quantity.

In conclusion, the workshop proved to be highly informative and insightful for all attendees. It provided practical guidance and ethical awareness to researchers at various stages of their academic journey. Dr. Vinoth Kumar K's session not only clarified the process of writing and publishing research papers but also emphasized the significance of maintaining integrity and quality in academic work. The participants gained a thorough understanding of how to navigate the complex landscape of research publication responsibly and effectively.
